

PUBLIC HEARING OF
VERMONTVILLE VILLAGE COUNCIL
NOVEMBER 3, 2005

Called to order at 6:31pm

Public Comments:

Gary McDiarmid expressed concern with trying to stay in line with other town's water and sewer rates as stated in the paper. Doug explained that we are not trying to be even with other towns but to bring in enough to cover our costs, with next years budget being 22,000.00 in the red. Usage rates have not increased for about 6 to 8 years.

Jason Sheridan suggested that readiness to serve charge be lowered and the usage be raised so as those who use the system more pay more. He understands that costs need to be covered.

Don Martin moved to recommend at the regular meeting to approve the .61 cent increase per thousand to the water usage only, seconded by Charlie Viele. Vote of all ayes (7).

Don Martin moved to adjourn the Public Hearing. Seconded by Sue Villanueva, all ayes.
