Medicare changes can help you save money this year!

Starting in 2010, changes in the Medicare program will make it easier for some older adults to get free Medicare Part B prescription drug coverage! The Medicare Savings Program may pay for your monthly Part B premium and the Medicare Extra Help Program helps with the cost of prescription drug coverage. The application for the Medicare Savings Program and the Extra Help Program has been simplified and the asset limits have been increased. This means even if you did not qualify before, you may qualify now for help with Medicare costs!

MiCAFE can help you apply for both programs! MiCAFE helps older adults apply for benefits that can boost your budget and help pay for medical costs, prescriptions, utilities and groceries. MiCAFE and its team of volunteers can help you, or someone you care about, apply in a senior-friendly place near your home. MiCAFE works one-on-one with you at your local senior center, so there are no long lines to wait in and no interviews with the Department of Human Services (DHS).

We know times are hard in Michigan. Take advantage of these new changes to the Medicare program, and if you qualify, you could keep that \$96.40 or more in your Social Security check each month!
