About the Program

The Senior Dine Program is a donation based electronic voucher program offered by Tri-County Office on Aging in partnership with local restaurants.

Who is eligible?

Seniors over 60 years of age who

are at nutritional risk. may seldom socialize with friends and family. meet income guidelines.

Each person is interviewed personally to determine eligibility.

How the program works

The dine card is swiped at the register and accepted as payment for the meal.

Cardholders order from a special menu designed to meet the dietary needs of senior citizens.

The participating restaurant in Vermontville is the SUGAR HUT CAFE
