

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Thursday January 14, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., the Planning Commission of the Village of Vermontville will hold a public hearing at the Vermontville Community Center, 108 North Main Street, Vermontville, Michigan, on two proposed ordinances to amend the zoning ordinance. The first proposed ordinance would amend Sections 6.2, 7.9, and 8.4 of the zoning ordinance related to the keeping, raising and use of farm animals and backyard farm animals in the Village. The second proposed ordinance would amend Sections 7.1, 7.3, 7.9, 8.45, 17.6, 20.11, 20.31, 21.4 and 21.8 by providing various non-material updates to terms and citation references in the listed sections.

In compliance with Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Orders and/or legislative amendments to the Open Meetings Act, the Vermontville Planning Commission, in order to protect the public health, may conduct this hearing via electronic communications. Any member of the public wishing to listen and/or watch the proceedings and/or provide public comment may do so. A copy of the proposed amending ordinances are on file and may be examined at the Village Office, 194 S Main St, Vermontville during Village office hours. All interested persons may attend the public hearing and comment upon the proposed ordinance.
