

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

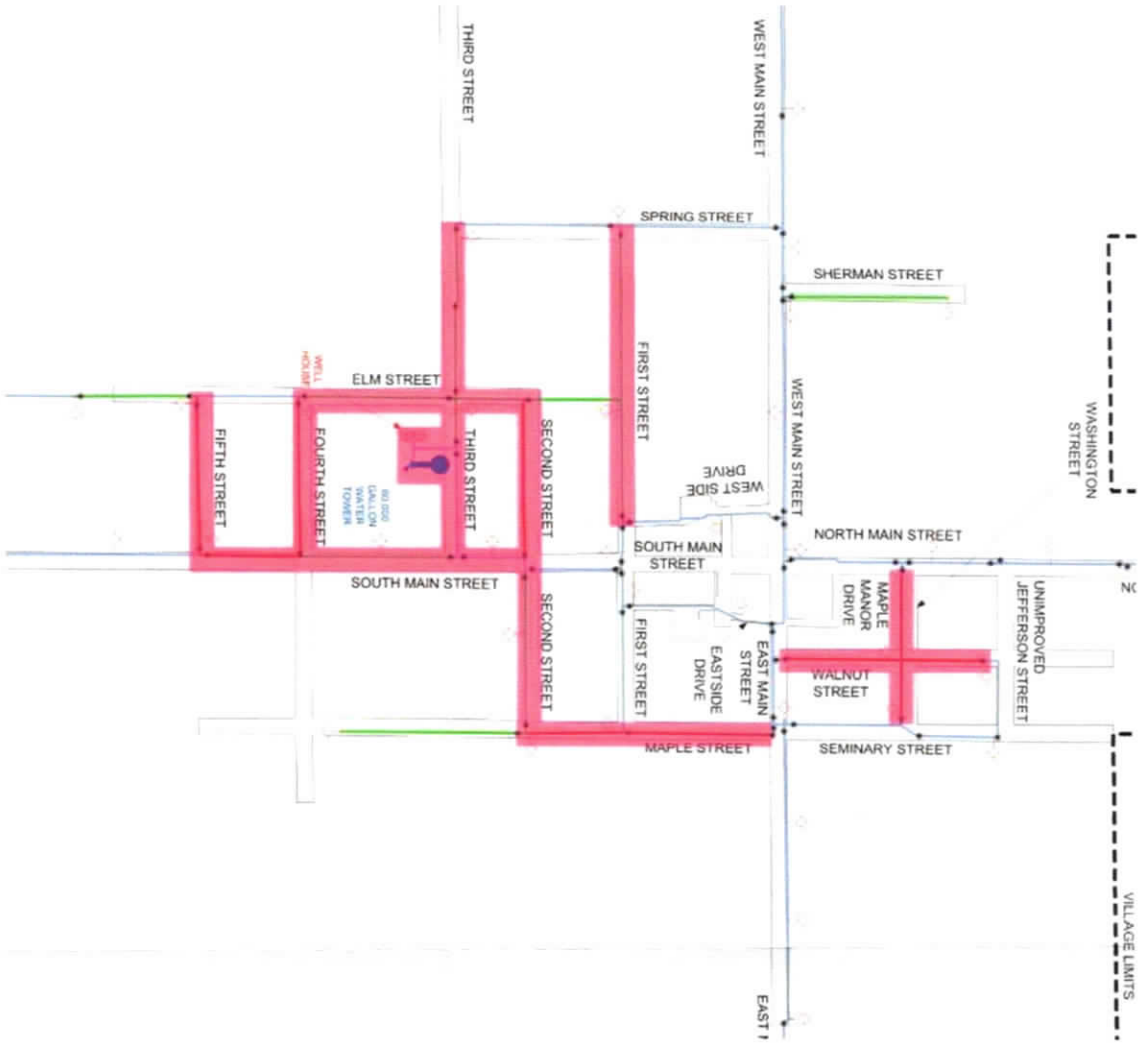
Village of Vermontville Residents,

This letter is to inform you that the Village of Vermontville is starting the 2021 water system improvements beginning in July and continuing for the rest of the year. Please be patient with us as we strive to improve the quality and reliability of the water system for the Village of Vermontville users. Included is the map of all the areas where construction will take place. All residents will have access to their properties at the end of every workday, while the construction company works diligently to maintain drivable roadways throughout the construction zones during the project

Consumers Energy will also be replacing gas main around the water system improvements, beginning the end of June, and continuing through August of 2021.

The water tower installation is projected to begin in early 2021 and continue through 2022 before the storage tank will be in service. The Tower installation will take place just a little Southwest of the current water tower location on the same property. It is anticipated that any disturbance to traffic for this portion of the project will be minimal, if any.
